Day By Day Itinerary

Day 1 – Arrive Hanoi – You will be met and transferred by private driver and guide to your hotel.

Day 2 – Full day tour with your private guide exploring the sights and sounds of Hanoi. Highlights include visiting the HCM Mausoleum, Temple of Literature and a fascinating one hour cyclo tour around the “old quarter”.

Day 3 – This morning you will transfer to the UNESCO World Heritage listed Halong Bay for your luxury two night cruise on a traditional Vietnamese junk.

Day 4 – Full day exploring the awe-inspiring scenery of Halong Bay.



Day 5 – You will cruise leisurely back to the harbour this morning and transfer to Hanoi via a traditional water puppet village. This evening you will take a flight to historical Hue.

Day 6 – Your guide and driver will meet you this morning for your private trip on the romantically named Perfume River to see the Thien Mu Pagoda and visit the eerie mausoleum of Vietnam’s last imperial emperor, Minh Mang.

Day 7— This morning you will be met by your driver and guide and transferred to the picturesque port town of Hoi An which will take you over the spectacular Hai Van Pass and includes stops at the Cham museum, China Beach and the Marble Mountains.



Day 8 – You will be met by your guide this morning and embark on a leisurely 2 hour walking tour around Hoi-An’s old town. As well as witnessing the locals go about their morning chores you will visit a selection of temples, merchant houses and other sites such as the historical Japanese Bridge.

Day 9 – Full day to explore Hoi An at your own pace.

Day 10 – This morning you will transfer to nearby Danang Airport for your onward flight to Saigon. On arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Day 11— This morning you will transfer to the Me-kong Delta to join your private traditional Vietnamese sampan for a cruise around the backwaters. The day includes lots of sightseeing and wonderful food (lunch & dinner) as well as stops at local markets and ancient houses.

Day 12 – In the early morning visit the local floating markets (not tourist traps like in Bangkok) – here you will see locals trading all sorts of goods brought in from miles around. A colourful and memorable experience! Return to Saigon in the early afternoon and transfer to your hotel.

Day 13 —You will be met this morning by your driver and guide for your half day tour out to the Cu Chi Tunnels. Your guide around the tunnels is Uncle Nam a local war veteran who fought in the tunnels for twelve years.

Day 14 —You will be transferred to the airport today to meet your international flight back to Australia.
